








- Each Circuit hired a Coordinator





## Outcomes for SC in Reducing Underage Drinking

Youth Risk Behavior Survey 2005 & 2015

Survey Item	2005	2015	% decrease
high school students reported ever drinking alcohol	71.1%	58.0%	-18.4%
reported drinking alcohol before age 13	25.6%	21.4%	-16.4%
reported drinking alcohol in past 30 days	43.2%	28.4%	-34.3%
reported binge drinking (5 or more drinks in 2 hour time period) in past 30 days	23.6%	11.7%	-50.4%
