## **Marijuana Factsheet**

This factsheet provides an overview of **marijuana use** as reported by the participants of the 2022 Communities that Care survey.

#### **Risk Behavior**



7.2% of students have been drunk or high at school in the past year.



In the past month, **12.2%** of students have ridden with a driver who had been using marijuana.

In the past month, **3.1%** of students have drove after using marijuana.



In the past year, **2.8%** of students have **sold** illegal drugs.

In the past year, **1.5%** of students have **attacked someone** due to drugs.

Perception of Risk	Percent of Students Lifetime and Current Marijuana
<b>58.3 %</b> of students believe that a person has <b>moderate or great risk</b> of harming themselves physically or in other ways if they use marijuana <b>once or twice per week.</b>	Use 16.2% of students have used marijuana (weed, pot) or hashish (hash, hash oil) in their lifetime. In the past 30 days, 8.9% of students have used marijuana (weed, pot) or hashish (hash, hash oil).

### **Access to Substance**

**42.0%** of students stated that it is **easy** to obtain marijuana.

18.5% of students obtain marijuana by buying if from a friend.

#### **Disapproval of Use**

**85.7%** of students think their **parents** would feel it's **wrong** for them to use marijuana.

60.0% of students think their **peers** would feel it's **wrong** for them to use marijuana.

62.0% of students think it's wrong for someone their age to use marijuana.
