| Percent of Students Lifetime and Current Tobacco Use 23.3% of students have smoked e-cigarettes or vape pens in their lifetime and 13.4% are currently. 6.8% of students have smoked cigarettes in their lifetime and 1.3% currently smoke cigarettes. 5.0% of student have used smokeless tobacco in their lifetime and 2.0% currently use. 95.9% of students have never smoked a cigarette or was 13 or older when they had their first one. | |

Disapproval of Use

94.3% of students think their **parents** would feel it's **wrong** for them to smoke cigarettes and **89.5%** also think their **parents** would feel it's **wrong** for them to smoke e-cigarettes or vaping pens.

78.5% of students think their **peers** would feel it's **wrong** for them to smoke cigarettes and **58.9%** also think their **peers** would feel it's **wrong** for them to smoke e-cigarettes or vaping pens.

80.6% of students think it's **wrong** for **someone their age** to smoke cigarettes and **65.9%** also think it's **wrong** for **someone their age** to smoke e-cigarettes or vaping pens.
