Youth Access to Tobacco Study





What does the federal Synar study nn9

The Synar Amendment was developed and implemented in July 1992 in the context of a growing body of evidence about the health problems related to tobacco use by youth, as well as evidence about the ease with which youth could purchase tobacco products through retail sources.

According to YRBS, the percentage of students reporting current cigarette use dropped from 34.8% in 1995 to 6.0% in 2019.

proactive/preventative **Tobacco Education Program**

Education

- training prevention specialists to understand the effects of nicotine
- prevention education programs that emphasize the dangers and risks of tobacco and nicotine

- year-round tobacco compliance checks
- environmental scans of local retailers for emerging products

Enforcement

- merchant education
- multi-jurisdictional agreements
- outlet list cleaning
- policy review
















South Carolina must:



follow every SAMHSA guideline

SC is held accountable for following the study the way we said we would!



conduct a sampling of tobacco outlets from each county in the state

(and report this method to SAMHSA)



conduct a sampling of tobacco outlets from each county in the state



achieve a noncompliance rate of no more than 20%

(SAMHSA requires that each state reduce its retailer violation rate to 20%).



State & County Synar Tasks



- DAODAS compiles a sampling list of all outlets in the state (FDA, DOR, SC Lottery)
- uses SAMHSA methodology for outlet selection
- assign outlets, products, age groups
- create YATS forms for each outlet, print, and mail to counties

Counties select a Synar coordinator, train on Relias, and begin to recruit youth for the study

Each Year Rotates: Two Options

- 16-17 and 18-20 year olds
- cigarettes or cigarettes & ENDS
- Group 1 (Fall) Group 2 (Spring)
- Verifies outlets are valid for study (important for replacements)

FUNDING!

Not only prevention funding but 10% of the entire SUPTR BG



Adult & Youth ID

The instructions for creating the Youth ID Code are detailed on the Youth Master List. THE FIRST TWO VALUES OF ADULT AND YOUTH ID CODES MUST BE LETTERS. (See examples below.)

Youth Name	Youth Initials	Last 4 Digits of Youth SSN	Youth ID Code
Tina Salem	TS	8248	TS8248
Joseph Kamel	JK	4491	JK4491
Winston Hack	WH	1528	WH1528
Ann Orien	AO	7640	AO7640

If a youth does not know the last four digits of his/her SSN, you can substitute the last four digits of his/her home telephone number.

Outlet Safety

- Safety can be subjective, ask your local LEO!
- Upon verifying outlets, request a replacement!
- Please state why your outlet was unsafe
- Can lead to problems with study sample if not replaced
